2.1.1 Membership Coordinator Areas of Focus

2.1.1.1 Prayer Card Initiative

Four sets of prayer cards will be distributed to District Deputies across Colorado. This program is meant to be an outreach to the parishes. The request is simple: ask the Pastor for permission to distribute the prayer card and if he would be willing to lead the community in prayer on the day of their distribution. Four sets of prayer cards were chosen so that one could be distributed per quarter in the parish.

2.1.1.2 Shining Knight

Awarded for service to your council and our Order with distinction, the Shining Knight Award is awarded to those men that exemplify a true Knight of Columbus.

The Shining Knight Award program is designed for members of your council to engage in and maintain an active level of participation in council programs and activities.

To qualify for the Shining Knight Award, during the fraternal year, brother Knights must:

- Be involved in at least 3 council Faith in Action programs.
- Attend at least 3 council meetings.
- Attend an Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity.
- Meet with your council's insurance representative or attend a fraternal benefits night.
- Sponsor at least one man who becomes a member of the Order

2.1.2 Program Coordinator Areas of Focus

2.1.2.1 Coats for Kids

The Coats for Kids Program has become an important initiative for the Knights of Columbus, especially here in Colorado where the weather can dip to dangerous levels. Not all families can afford a reliable coat for their children, we as Knights of Columbus have a duty to help provide those coats. The KoC have distributed over a million coats throughout the US and Canada since the program's inception in 2009. We will be starting to contact councils for their orders soon! Be ready to place an order for these coats, Supreme will match coat for coat, so if your council purchases 100 coats, Supreme will purchase for your council an additional 100.

2.1.2.2 Silver Rose

Each year, from early March through mid-December, Silver Roses are stewarded by councils along routes from Canada to Mexico. Every stop the Silver Rose makes throughout the pilgrimage is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners, and community members to pray for respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of each nation, and for the advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe. 3.2 Membership Incentives

3.2.1 Membership Recruitment Incentives

- **Insurance Agents**
 - Highest recruiting agent for the Fraternal Year (July 1 – June 30) gets a \$1,000.00 Visa Gift Card (Split between the Wheaton Agency and State Council) – Minimum of 25 new members to qualify
 - If you recruit over 30 new members, the State Council will pay for your room at the State Convention.

- **Councils**

- **Q1**

- Councils that did not recruit one (1) new member (ZERO members) last year will receive one chance for a \$200.00 drawing for every new member brought into the council before September 30th, 2025. Drawing will be held October 1st.

- **Q2**

- Councils that reach 100% of their membership quota by December 31st will receive a custom Navy Banner for their Council.
- Councils that reach 150% of their membership quota by December 31st we will enter you into a drawing for a Black Stone 4 Burner Liquid Propane outdoor Griddle. (Drawing for up to 3)

- **Q3**

- Councils that reach 200% of their membership quota by March 31st, 2026, the State Council will enter you into a drawing for a Knights of Columbus branded 10x10 EZ Up Canopy, customizable to your council. (Up to 3)
- The Top 2 Councils that have 7 Shining Knights, who are New Knights brought on THIS Fraternal Year, will receive for their Grand Knight and District Deputy a Classic 22" Duffel Bag – Hig Sierra 22" Bubba Duffel Bag.

- **ALL YEAR**

- Quarterly winners for Top Recruiter will receive a Knights branded Field & Co. 20 Inch Duffel bag SKU 7950-80-Light Gray. (This award can only be won once during the fraternal year by any single Knight.)
- Top recruiting District Deputy each fraternal quarter receives a Field & Co. 20 Inch Duffel bag SKU 7950-80-Light Gray (This award can only be won once during the fraternal year by any single knight)
- 1st council to recruit and exemplify 20 new members in a quarter will receive - Custom Council Tablecloth for 8 foot table SKU NP-8ft-TBL-CST. This incentive will be held each **Quarter** of the fraternal year.
- There will be 3 drawings, one each for Knights, Field Agents and Councils, that recruit 12 new members by the State Convention – the winner of each will receive a \$250 Amazon gift card.

- Districts that reach Star Council – Districts that reach Star Council Status by June 1st, 2026 will have the District Deputy get a Knights branded Elleven TSA 17” Computer Backpack.
- Top Recruiter in Colorado by April 1st, 2026 will have one nights hotel and the banquet covered by the State Council for him and his wife.

3.2.2 Shining Knight Recruitment Incentive

- Top two councils (must have at least 7 Shining Knights (for new Knights only) by March 31st) will receive, for their Grand Knight and District Deputy, Classic 22” Duffel Bag – High Sierra 22” Bubba Duffel Bag – Knights Gear USA.

3.2.3 Reactivation Award

- The council that reactivates brothers from the affiliate member program the most members a year or more will win the Reactivation Award. Let’s bring these brothers back to the fold.

4.0 State Council Awards & Points Summary

4.1 Overview

The Colorado State Knights of Columbus Awards Program celebrates participation in Programming and Membership Activities. The State Awards Program has been reviewed by the Membership and Program Coordinators and refinements have been made to encourage Council participation.

4.2 Monthly Colorado State Awards:

- Knight of the Month
- Family of the Month

4.2.1 Knight of the Month Award

Councils should honor their Knights who make outstanding contributions to their parish and community and live the spirit of Columbianism by recognizing them as a Knight of the Month. The State Council recognizes a Knight of the Month from those selected as Knight of the Month by their council. To be considered for the State Knight of the Month

honor, entries must be submitted to the State Knight of the Month Chairman by the due date of the 15th of the month following the month nominated. Knight of the Month forms (10764) can be found on the State Council website or at this link:

The monthly winners chosen by the State will receive a St. Francis ICON along with a recognition certificate from the State Deputy.

4.2.2 Family of the Month Award

Councils should honor their families who make outstanding contributions to their parish and community and live in the spirit of Columbianism by recognizing them as a Family of the Month. Councils are encouraged to choose families from the parish who are led by potential Knights as well as outstanding Knight families. The State Council recognizes a Family of the Month from those selected as Family of the Month by their council. To be considered for the State Family of the Month honor, entries must be NOT LATER THAN the 15th of the month following the month nominated. 4.3.1 Membership Awards

Awards will be presented to the councils having the top recruiting numbers, the top recruiting Knight, the top recruiting Field Agent, the top performing Field Agent, the top referring council, the top referring Knight, the Shining Knights as they occur during the year and the top three councils Shining Knight regarding the number of Shining Knights reported.

Use the State Council Membership Awards Form in the forms section of this Handbook for each Shining Knight report. All Membership Program Award reports must be sent to the State Membership Coordinator by February 1st.

4.3.1.1 Top Recruiting Council

This award will be given to the Top Recruiting Council by intake of new members. This will be determined by tracking of the Membership Coordinator, no report is needed.

- One award given to the council with the largest absolute growth
- One award will be given to the council with the largest relative (%) growth

There is an additional award presented to the council by the Supreme Council called the Contest of Champions that is awarded to the Top Council for absolute growth and for Percentage Growth. With both the State and Supreme Awards, the same council CAN win both awards.

4.3.1.2 Top Recruiting Knight

This award will be given to the single Knight of Columbus in Colorado that recruited the single largest number of candidates to the Order. This will be determined by tracking of the Membership Coordinator, no report is needed.

4.3.1.3 Top Recruiting Field Agent

This award will be given to the single Knight of Columbus Field Agent in Colorado that recruited the single largest number of candidates to the Order. This will be determined by tracking of the Membership Coordinator, no report is needed.

4.3.1.4 Shining Knight Awards

Awarded for service to your council and our Order with distinction, the Shining Knight Award is awarded to those men that exemplify a true Knight of Columbus.

The Shining Knight Award program is designed for members of your council to engage in and maintain an active level of participation in council programs and activities.

To qualify for the Shining Knight Award, during the fraternal year, brother Knights must:

- Be involved in at least 3 council Faith in Action programs.
- Attend at least 3 council meetings.
- Attend an Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity.
- Meet with your council's insurance representative or attend a fraternal benefits night.
- Sponsor at least one man who becomes a member of the Order

Complete the Shining Knight Award application in section 6.0 of this guide.

4.3.1.5 Top Three Shining Knight Councils

Top three Councils that have recruited at least 3 Shining Knights in the Fraternal Year.

4.3.2 Program Awards

4.3.2.1 Service Activity Program Awards (Supreme & State)

Awards will be presented to the Councils having the best individual programs in each of the Faith In Action Program categories (Faith, Family, Community, and Life). The Supreme Award will be presented to the Councils have the best activity in each category and the State Award will be presented to the Council having the second-best program in each category. The Supreme Award winners will have their program submitted to the Supreme Council for entry in the international competition.

A council may win only ONE of the Supreme or State Service Awards per calendar year.

Councils are encouraged to submit a State Council Service Program Awards Entry Form (#STSP) for their council's best program in each program area in a calendar year before the deadline of February 1st. Programs must be organized by the council or involve significant participation by council members to qualify. Programs must also engage members by enhancing faith and spirituality, serving a charitable purpose, or a combination of the two. Program descriptions should reference how they meet these criteria. Along with the description of the program, provide the program's purpose, goals, accomplishments and why it deserves to win the award. Supplementary material

may be submitted along with the nomination. Accompanying materials can include letters, testimonials, news clippings, photographs, pamphlets, etc. Do not submit tapes, videocassettes, DVD's, display materials, films, etc., as they will not be considered in judging the nomination.

Here are some criteria that distinguish winners for the Service Program Awards.

- Based on activities and programs held in the calendar year
- Growth of Catholic principles and faith formation amongst the Council members
- Activities had tangible effects on others in the council, parish, or community
- Programs assist the council in its efforts to grow the order
- There is documented evidence of pastoral involvement
- Unique or innovative programs will be scored higher.

4.3.2.2 Father Francis Kappes Chaplain of the Year Award

This award is presented to an Outstanding Chaplain in the State. A Council Chaplain is vital to the spiritual growth of Knights and their families and will help encourage our children to respect and appreciate our Clergy and grow in Our Faith. Councils can submit their nomination for Chaplain of the Year by completing the State Blessed Michael McGivney Award form (#SBMMA) found under Council Forms at the Supreme website. The award application must be sent to the State Program Coordinator by February 1st. The award winner will also be nominated for the Supreme Council's Michael McGivney Medal Award.

Here are some criteria that distinguish winners for the Chaplain of the Year Award.

- Based on activities and programs held in the calendar year
- Sustained participation throughout the calendar year
- Growth of Catholic principles and faith formation amongst the Council members
- Activities had tangible effects on others in the council, parish, or community

Councils that submit the winning Chaplain will also receive an Award from Supreme for their work in submitting their winning Chaplain.

4.3.2.3 John J. Mildenerger Pro-Life Couple of the Year Award

The Couple/Knight who best demonstrates commitment and results in the calendar year to the Life program defined by Faith In Action is honored with this award. To qualify, the couple must be nominated by their Council using the form found in Appendix A. The Pro-Life Couple of the Year form may be accompanied by not more than 10 pages containing pictures, clippings or other information describing the nominee's qualifications. The award application must be sent to the State Program Coordinator by February 1st.

Here are some criteria that distinguish winners for the John J. Mildenerger Pro-Life Couple of the Year Award.

- Based on activities and programs held in the calendar year
- Sustained participation throughout the calendar year
- Activities had tangible effects on others in the council, parish, or community
- Inspired others to participate in Culture-of-Life programs/activities
- Couple/Knight models an active Catholic spirituality
- Both husband & wife (if applicable) participated either on same activities or separate activities during the calendar year

4.3.2.4 Knight of the Year

The entry form for Knight of the Year found in the section of this Handbook on forms must be submitted. The Knight of the Year form may be accompanied by not more than 10 pages containing pictures, clippings, or other information (the degree the Knight has attained, parish name and location, current council office, Past GK or Past FN. Please describe the Knight's effort in support of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism as well as his activities in support of the Order's Faith in Action programs) describing the nominee's qualifications. Additionally, include a color photo (head and shoulders) of the nominee. The winner is submitted to the Supreme Council for selection as the Supreme Knight of the Year. The award application for Knight of the Year must be sent to the State Service Program Coordinator by February 1st.

Here are some criteria that distinguish winners for the Knight of the Year Award.

- Based on activities and programs held in the calendar year
- Sustained participation throughout the calendar year
- Activities had tangible effects on others in the council, parish, or community
- Inspired others to participate in programs/activities
- Brought new Knights into the Council and provided mentoring of new Knights - Identify hours spent on each project described

4.3.2.5 Family of the Year

To be considered for this award, the Family must have been recognized by the council as a monthly Family of the Month winner. The entry form for Family of the Year is a Supreme form (#10680) and found on the Supreme Council website and must be submitted. The nomination MUST include the current Family of the Year nomination form (both pages) and a family picture. The form may be accompanied by not more than 10 pages containing pictures, clippings or other information describing the nominee's qualifications. The State winner will be submitted to the Supreme Council for consideration as the Supreme Family of the Year. The award application must be sent to the State Program Coordinator by February 1st.

Here are some criteria that distinguish winners for the Family of the Year Award.

- Based on activities and programs held in the calendar year
- Sustained participation throughout the calendar year
- Activities had tangible effects on others in the council, parish, or community
- Inspired others to participate in programs/activities

- Brought families together in activities (describe activities/events)
- Identify hours spent on each project described

4.3.3 Overall Awards

4.3.3.1 Top 25 Councils

Awards will be given to the top 25 councils in the state, determined by points. See below for the points breakdown.

4.3.3.2 Division Awards

Councils will also be awarded division trophies. Six divisions have been made to equalize the competition across the State. The Divisions are defined by Council membership as of January 1 prior to the beginning of each fraternal year. For example, for the 2025 – 2026 fraternal year, the State will use the council membership number as of January 1, 2025. The membership total is defined as the number of Associate and Insurance members in each Council. Inactive members are not counted in the Council membership total. It is not a requirement to have positive membership and insurance growth to be eligible for a Division Award.

The division trophy will be presented to the First Place Council. Below are the Division breakouts:

The Top Division winners will be determined based on the total earned points for the calendar year (Jan 1 to Dec 31). Refer to the Point Calculation section for details on the total points a Council can earn.

4.3.3.3 Saint Joseph Award

At his installation, Supreme Knight Kelly consecrated his term of service to Saint Joseph. Every Council can win the Saint Joseph Award. This award is based on participation in the Fraternal Benefits Program, Membership Program and completing certain Forms.

This award is based on three high-level criteria:

- Earn all Administrative Points available to your Council:
 - o Submit Forms 185, 365, 1728 with copies to the State Council
- Participate in events to qualify for the Founders' Award by participation in Fraternal Benefits Seminars
- Your Council must experience positive membership growth
