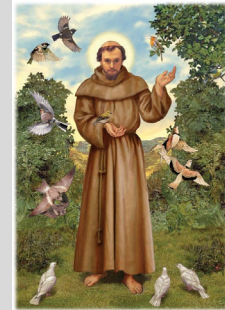

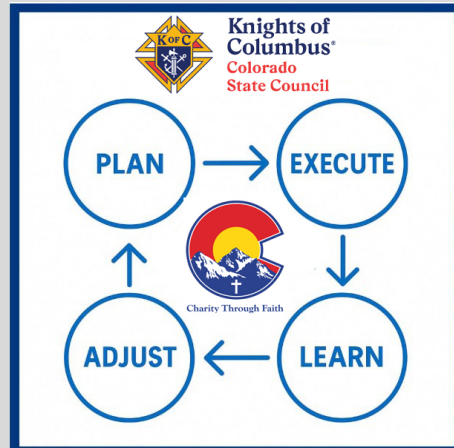

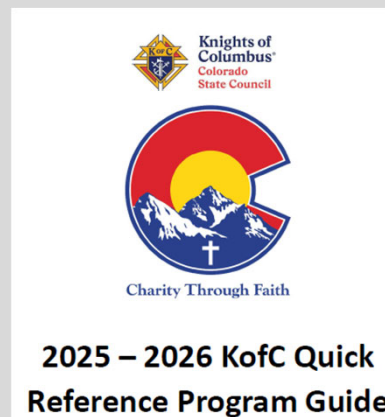
PROGRAMS

Featured Programs Minimum Requirements

FEATURED PROGRAMS
The Supreme Council will award select programs as featured programs in each of the four program categories. When your council conducts a featured program and satisfies the associated requirements it will receive two credits towards that program category on the *Catholic Award Appraisal* (PFA-3). At the end of the year, report all completed programs on the *Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity* (PFA-2). For additional Featured Program information, review the individual program guide sheets found at <http://www.kofc.org/resources>. All program forms may be found at kfc.org/forms.

FAITH
REFUND SUPPORT VACATIONS PROGRAM (RSVP)
Councils are required to donate at least \$500 to an individual seminarian or religious student. For every \$500 donated, Supreme will refund the council or assembly \$500, with a maximum refund of \$400 per individual supported. Report activity using the *RSVP Refund Appraisal* (PFA-4).

HOLY HOUR
Councils are required to hold at least four Holy Hours (quarterly) or organize and support two Holy Hours and at least one Eucharistic Procession. Report activity using the *Program Report Form* (PFA-3).

INTO THE BREACH
Councils are required to hold eight sessions to discuss the content of the original *Into the Breach* video series or equivalent expansion of 2016 or two sessions of the *Breach: The Mission of the Family* video series. Report activity using the *Program Report Form* (PFA-3).



Featured Programs

- Review linked document provided earlier
- Only specific programs can be marked on SP-7 as "Featured Programs"
- Councils do NOT need any featured programs!
- Featured Programs can reduce the number of programs needed for a Columbian Award, but only if you meet the documented criteria
- "When your council conducts a featured program and satisfies the associated requirements it will receive two credits towards that program category on the [SP-7]. At the end of the year, report all completed programs on the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity (#1728)"
